GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Any student Admitted to B.Tech/M.Tech/MBA/MCA under Nehru Group of Institutions, Kerala shall undergo the prescribed course of study as per the stipulations of Government of Kerala/APJ Abdul Kalam Technological University and directions of AICTE, New Delhi.
2. College working hours will be between 8.30 am and 5.30 pm on all working days.
3. As far as possible the students must attend all classes throughout the course achieving 100% attendance
4. Attendance is marked for each subject. 75% attendance is mandatory for each subject for writing the university examinations. Under unavoidable circumstances students are permitted to take leave. Duty leave is applied if and only the attendance is 65 % and above. Leave is normally sanctioned for any approved activity taken up by students outside the College covering sports and other extra-curricular activities. Leave is also permitted on medical grounds or on personal exigencies. Leave of absence for all these is limited to 25% of the academic contact hours for the course. In case of long illness or major personal tragedies / contingencies the College, Principal can relax the minimum attendance requirement to 60% to write the end semester examinations. This is permitted for one or more courses registered in the semester. Principal will keep all records which lead to his/her decisions on attendance, for verification by the academic auditor. However this concession is applicable only to any 2 semesters during the entire programme. In case of prolonged illness, break of study is permitted. Other leave rules as per KTU Ordinance.
5. Students are required to follow the proper procedure while availing leave. A leave requisition form has to be submitted to the Class Advisor/ HOD either before or immediately after availing leave with the permission of parent / guardian. Medical certificate can be attached if leave is more than 3 days continuously.
6. Students are required to attend classes wearing decent attire.
7. Students are expected to take care of their personal property and the College Authority accepts no responsibility in respect of the loss of property of students in the College premises or for accidental injury caused during the course.
8. All entries made in the application for admission ought to be correct and authentic and no material shall be concealed.
9. a)*All fees pertaining to the college are to be paid on or before the prescribed date intimated in the prospectus or calendar and as per the undertaking provided.



- b) For the late payment of fees, late fees may be levied.
- c) Course discontinuous and refund of fees will be applicable as per the Govt Order / AICTE Norms.
10. All original certificates are to be deposited with the College and the same will be forwarded to the University for the Verification.
11. For every payment which should be made to the College Office, areceipt in the proper form duly signed by the Accountant should be obtained.
12. Every student will be issued an identity card on admission. This card is to be returned on completion of the course. In case of loss of the ID a duplicate one may be issued at a cost when an affidavit is provided by the student.
13. Any other lawful due to the College should be paid promptly when the College makes a request.
14. Students are required to undertake Industrial visit and Internship as an integral part of the course and expense for the same should be borne by them.
15. Every student should get admitted to the course at the beginning of every academic year respective of the duration of the course. This is to ensure by the Principal that the deficiencies noted in the performance of the students in the preceding academic year are made good by proper counseling and other remedial measures by the College. Application will be supplied for the said readmission at free of cost. If deficiencies are not removed totally, the student may be given conditional admission with proper undertaking by the student jointly with the parent. When readmitted to the higher class a readmission card will be issued to the student by the Principal. Incase of readmission for an year out / under break of study student should apply for readmission to the University through Principal. Further on confirmation of readmission the student shall pay the requisite tuition fees to the college and readmission slip to be obtained from the Academic Office.
16. Those students who have not sought readmission nor paid the fees for the next academic year shall cease to have their names in rolls of the college and they shall not be permitted to attend the classes without complying these formalities. Parents and students are requested to cooperate with the college authorities in this regard.
17. First year students are advised to stay in college hostel or must come from their respective home. No students are allowed to stay outside the Campus as Paying Guest / sharing accommodation etc..
18. a) List of working days and holidays given in the KTU academic calendar are applicable to the students.

b) Holidays for faculties and administrative staffs will be declared as and when required.

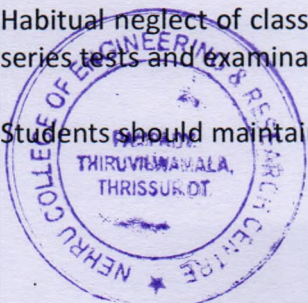




- c) Students can download all forms related to academic and non-academic from the respective college websites for their usage (Eg:-TC Request Form, Migration Certificate, Leave Application, Hostel Admission and Relieving form, Caution deposit refund form, Dues clearance form, Bus passform, etc.).
19. Students should follow the traffic rules strictly inside the Campus and vehicles should park only in the designated parking area. Entry beyond that point is strictly prohibited.
 20. Bike race / motor car race / elephant procession or similar activities should not be permitted inside the Campus / Hostels.
 21. No type of vehicles should be used during celebrations inside the College Campus and Hostels.
 22. In the interest of security of students, Police may be informed in advance about all festival celebrations.

REGULATIONS OF ATTENDANCE

1. Latecomers shall be permitted to enter the class during class hours. However they will not be permitted attendance for that particular hour.
2. Students are required to follow the proper procedure while availing leave. A leave requisition form has to be submitted to the Class Advisor / HOD either before or immediately after availing leave with the permission of parent / guardian. In case of long leave due to medical reasons, the leave form should be supported with a medical certificate.
3. Leave letter must be submitted after getting endorsement from Faculty Advisor and forwarded through the HOD & Principal.
4. Students are expected to reach the college on time and attend all the classes till the scheduled closing time. They are required to obtain permission from the faculty advisor and the HOD in case they have to leave during class hours.
5. Students are expected to be in their respective classes before the commencement of the classes. Students of one branch should not go to the other classes or junior classes.
6. During class hours, students should remain in the class irrespective of whether the faculty has come or not. After 5 minutes, the class representative must inform this matter to the HOD.
7. No student shall leave the classroom without the permission of the Faculty Member. During class hours they shall not be permitted to go out of the class.
8. Students shall keep their seats and classroom in a neat condition and arrangements should not be disturbed or furniture dislocated.
9. Habitual neglect of class work, non-submission of assignments and projects, record books, series tests and examination shall be viewed seriously.
10. Students should maintain decorum, discipline and good behavior during functions.

11. They should bring the respective notebooks, assignment books, drawing instruments, drawing sheets etc. when they come to the class.

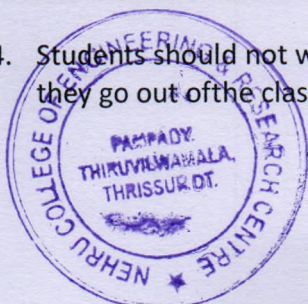
12. They should complete the record books before entering the laboratories.

REGULATIONS OF DRESS

1. Proper dress code (uniform of the College) should be adhered to before entering the classrooms, laboratories or workshop on all working days.
2. All students have to wear Identity Card in the college premises in proper manner. The same should be produced when and where required in the campus. ID card is mandatory for all academics and non-academic matters.
3. Men students should come with proper uniform and insert their shirts and wear black leather shoes while coming to the College. Nobody should come with exotic hairstyles.
4. Women students should wear college uniform regularly with black shoes.
5. All students must wear lab coats and black shoes during workshops / lab hours.
6. Casual dresses, Tee Shirts, Jeans and Dhotis are not permitted during academic sessions / working hours.
7. Students are allowed to wear civil dresses on Wednesdays however, they should avoid fancy dresses, dhotis, T Shirts.
8. In case Wednesday happens to be an Examination day, those who are appearing for examination should come in uniform and are not allowed to come in civil dress.
9. The Principal / HODs and all Faculty Members are empowered to check the dress code of students.

REGULATIONS ON CONDUCT

1. Students should not get involved in any nefarious activities that will be degrading the college, state or nation.
2. Students should not indulge in bullying, eve-teasing or Ragging any other person. If they violate this rule, suitable action shall be initiated against them according to the relevant Indian Law.
3. Students should not smoke or use drugs, alcohol or any substance injurious to health within the College campus. If violated, serious action shall be initiated against them.
4. Students should not wander in the verandas or Corridors during class hours. Nor should they go out of the class unless called for by the College Authorities for some valid reason.





5. Any kind of misbehavior shall be viewed seriously.
6. Students shall not defile or desecrate the rooms, walls, floor, furniture and other equipments etc in the Campus. Any violation will attract suitable action, and steps shall be taken to procure the cost of repair / restoration from the student.
7. A student suspended twice and gets involved in misbehavior for the third time shall be summarily dismissed from the College.
8. Visitors / parents / guardians are not permitted to see the students during class hours. However under extra ordinary circumstances College Authorities may waive this clause.
9. Students must get permission before entering the staff room or office.
10. Students are responsible for the safe custody of tools/equipment /apparatus they use. In case of any damage, either willful or accidental, steps shall be taken to procure the cost of repair or in case of irreparable circumstances the cost of new equipment, from the student.
11. Political, union activities, dharnas, gharao and shouting slogans or mass boycotting from the classes are totally forbidden. Any violation will attract strict action. Admission is granted to the College under this specific condition alone, which parents may note. Admission to the higher class is also governed by this specific condition. These type of activities are totally banned by various court of law as per various judgments.
12. Usage of Mobile phone is banned inside the Class room/ laboratory/workshop and library. If somebody bring the mobile phone , it should be keep in separate place provided by the college. Carrying Mobile phones to examination halls are strictly prohibited and punishable crime.
13. Those students who go out of the Campus during Class hours (excluding lunch time) need to obtain permission slip from their respective HOD's / authorized person.

ACADEMIC REGULATIONS

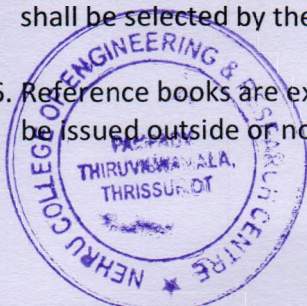
1. All students are put under the guidance of a Faculty Member for advice, help and monitoring the progress in studies, their well being and solving their personal problems.
2. The Faculty Advisor shall keep the Head of the Institution informed about the progress of students, their problems etc. The Faculty Advisor must maintain a record.
3. Parents must meet the Faculty Advisor / Principal at least once in a semester and get a feedback about their ward.
4. Students must be regular in attending series test and assignments.

LIBRARY REGULATIONS

1. Library will be kept open during the college working hours and Saturdays.
2. Each student is permitted to borrow 3 books at a time for a period of 14 days.
3. Students may take the book twice consecutively and after that it shall not be issued to the same student.
4. Each student may keep the book for 14 days and return the same. If not returned in time the Librarian shall fix an appropriate fine per day of default.
5. Strict silence is to be observed in the library.
6. Any misbehaviour in the library and any act of defiling books shall attract strict action. Steps shall be taken to procure the cost of repair/ restoration/replacement from the student.
7. Photocopying facilities are available and may be utilized by the students. For this the cost must be borne by the student.
8. Students shall leave the books on the table after reading and they are not expected to replace the books on the racks.
9. Reference books and journals shall not be issued to anybody.
10. Each student is expected to handle the books in careful manner.
11. While entering the library, member should leave their personal belongings in the shelf provided. They are allowed to take only loose sheets of writing papers within.
12. Member should see that the books they borrow are in good condition. If any book is found changed on returning, the concerned member is able to rectify/ compensate for the damage as decided by the librarian.
13. Members can reserve books by giving advance intimation to the librarian through the intent register.
14. Member should return the borrowed books on or before the due date. No reminder will be sent regarding the return of books. If a member fails to return the books in time he / she will have to pay fine of Rs2 per day per book. Ten days after the due date the fine will be increased to 10 per day per book till the book is returned or replaced.
15. If any student loses a book, he/ she should bear the cost of replacement of the book. In case the particular book is out of print, an alternative book of approximately the same cost shall be selected by the Principal and the cost shall be borne by the student.
16. Reference books are exclusively for reference purpose only within the library and will not be issued outside or no photo copying is allowed.

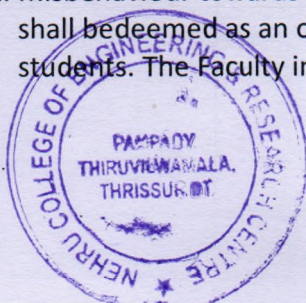




17. Library identity card is mandatory for library transaction.
18. Faculty members can borrow books only on the basis of issued library tickets from the office.
19. Any member violating the library rules and regulations will forfeit their privilege to utilize the library facilities forever.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR INDUSTRIAL VISITS

1. The students should not initiate the process of arranging Industrial visits and educational tours according to their whims and fancies.
2. The respective HODs should initiate the process of Industrial visit at least one month before the visit.
3. The detailed programme regarding the Industry to be visited, places, tentative date, and other details must be charted out and be routed through the Principal for approval.
4. The HOD may identify the tour representatives, treasurers and submit the detailed proposal for getting sanction from the industries concerned to the under signed through the Principal.
5. Only after obtaining the permission from industries concerned, the students can go on Industrial visit.
6. The trips should preferably be performed by train. Bus journeys can be arranged for places which can be accessed within a day or two.
7. The HOD should oversee the process through selected Faculties who shall accompany the students. Once assigned, the same Faculty must accompany the students and alternative arrangements are not allowed without the prior permission of the Principal.
8. Proper accounting of the collection and expense must be maintained and scrutinized by the HOD. These accounts must be submitted to Principal for approval.
9. The joint declaration by the students and their parents and the verification of the signature of the parents must be done by the HOD.
10. The declaration forms and the tour details must be submitted to the Director of Technical Education (DTE) for obtaining the sanction for the Industrial Visit.
11. Strict discipline and dignified behaviour are expected from the students.
12. Misbehaviour towards anybody, usage of tobacco, cigarettes or drugs and alcoholic drinks shall be deemed as an offence and disciplinary action shall be initiated against such students. The Faculty in charge should monitor these matters and be vigilant.

13. The places/hotels/ residences must be booked sufficiently early and their addresses and contact numbers be submitted to the undersigned. The tour diary and time table must be submitted in advance.
14. The students shall not go near dangerous spots, forbidden areas and other unwanted place.
15. Students are expected to behave decently and courteously towards each other.
16. No student shall be permitted to go out from the places of stay after 7 PM.
17. The tour party should start from the College at the appropriate time and they should break up in the College itself and not in between at an earlier date and in other places.
18. No student is permitted to leave the place other than the specified ones.
19. Any violation of these rules will attract strict disciplinary actions.
20. Regular reports about the progress of the tour shall be provided to the Principal on a daily basis.
21. Any extraordinary incident must be intimated to the Principal /College office immediately.

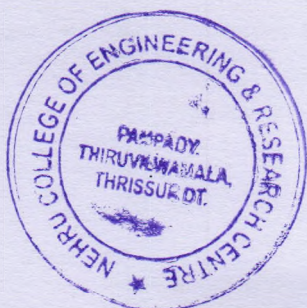



1. Standard Operating Procedure for Hostel

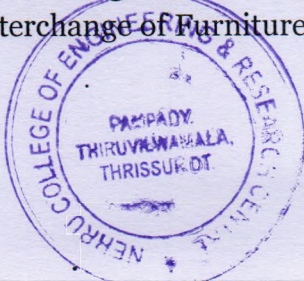
- i. All existing and the newly admitted students should read ALL the points carefully, before applying / check-in to Hostel accommodation at the start of every academic year. In case of any doubt, get them clarified from any of the Wardens. Violation of any of the rules stating ignorance will not be accepted and will attract disciplinary action.
- ii. All pages of this document are to be signed by the Student and his / her parent(s) and submitted before room allotment. Rooms shall be allotted on production of receipt of hostel and mess fee paid.
- iii. Hostel accommodation is not a matter of right of the student and allotment shall be made subject to availability of suitable space, based on adherence of rules contained in this document.
- iv. Provision of hostel accommodation at the time of admission doesn't ensure its continuation in the subsequent years. The student has to apply every year for re- allotment of hostel accommodation in the prefixed Performa. Re- allotment shall be on the basis of academic performance and other conditions as specified by the concerned authority.
 - a. Any cleanliness matter to be brought to the notice of the **Warden**
 - b. Mess to be informed about non-availability of students.
 - c. Inspection to be done by **Hostel Committee**.
 - d. Suggestion Box provided in the hostel to be opened every 15 days in the presence of **Warden and Student representative**.

2. Issues Related to Parents/Relatives/Visitors

- i. Parents/Guardians should give an undertaking to cooperate with the **Hostel authorities** and should be available on call as and when required and disclose all contact details.
- ii. Parents/Visitors are advised not to insist on entry beyond the designated area or visiting room as it shall disturb other students.

2. Use of Electronic/Electric items

- a. **Fixtures:** Students shall NOT bring any extra furniture or other fixtures in the room. All furniture and fixtures in the rooms allotted to students shall be cared for property. Students shall be required to pay the original cost of any item found missing from their room. Students shall also be required to pay the charges of repair to items that are found to have been willfully damaged or have been damaged on account of misuse or unfair wear and tear.
- b. **Interchange of Furniture/Fixture:** Students shall not interchange any furniture/



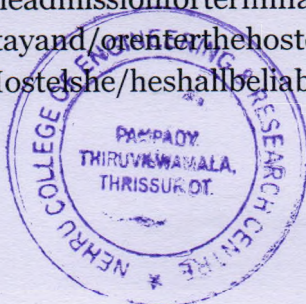


- fixture from one point/location in the hostel to another. Besides a penal recovery, students involved in such activities shall be expelled from the hostel.
- c. Assets in Common Areas/Corridors: Theft/damages to hostel assets in common areas/corridors shall be recovered from all students of the flank/wing involved. In case of theft/damage to items that pertain to usage by the complete hostel, the recoveries shall be made from all the occupants of the hostel.
 - d. Playing of tape – recorders and radio sets are prohibited in the hostel.
- 4. Induction Programme:** There will be a common induction programme for the hostel students where students would get an opportunity to interact with the students of other Institutes and Hostel.
- 5. Celebration of Birthdays**
- a. It shall be with prior written permission of the **Warden**.
 - b. It shall be held in a common place for one hour between 6.30 pm to 7.30 pm.
 - c. There shall not be any kind of physical discomfort.
 - d. No outside guest will be allowed.
 - e. Violation of the rule shall be penalized.
- 6. Attendance of Students in Hostel**
- a. Undertaking form will be taken from students for attendance.
 - b. Attendance of the students in the hostel will be taken strictly at 6.30 pm.
 - c. Any late comer will have to sign in a separate register.
 - d. The regular late comers shall be reported to parents on time.

Hostel Rules and Regulations

Disciplinary action as per Code of Conduct shall be taken against students violating Hostel Rules and Regulations.

1. It should be clearly understood by all residents that no tenancy shall be created by their occupation or use of hostel premises and property and that each of them is merely permitted by the **College Authorities**, under the rules and regulations framed by the **College Authorities** which can be changed, altered, modified, varied wholly or partly and can be replaced by **College Authorities** at their discretion and without assigning any reason for same. Upon such revocation the residents shall not be entitled to stay and/or enter the Hostel/Institute or any part or portion thereof. If she/he does not leave, she/he shall be liable to be forcibly removed.
2. Admission given is provisional and will be confirmed by the **Principal** of the respective Institute only after the medical examination and clearance given by the concerned Medical Authority. Any previous medical history should be disclosed by the student.
3. Any misleading or false statement or information in the application form shall render the admission for termination and on such termination students shall not be entitled to stay and/or enter the hostel or part thereof. If she/he does not leave the premises of the Hostel she/he shall be liable to be forcibly removed from the hostel.

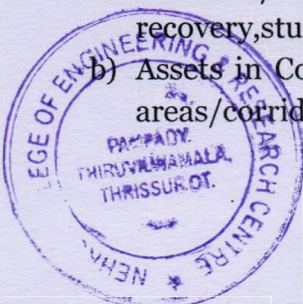
4. **The College Authority** reserves the right to terminate the occupancy of the student for any willful disobedience or defiance of authority, non-observance or frequent violation of hostel rules, causing damage to person or property or indulging in any anti-national or undesirable activities like any political activities, strike, dharnas, gharaos, demonstration in the College Campus or Hostel Premises or inducing others to do so. In such cases the deposit shall be forfeited and fees will NOT be refunded except the mess charges on pro-rata basis.
5. The _____ hostel _____ shall _____ be treated as an extension of the Institution and observance of rules and regulations of the Hostel shall be compulsory for all boarders.
6. Change/Inter-Change of Room: A student shall not change/interchange her/his room with another student or shift into a vacant room without the previous written permission of the **Warden / Principal**. The **Warden / Principal** has the right to shift a student from her/his room to another room in the hostel at any time without assigning any reason.
7. The hostel **warden** shall provide students, keys of the allotted room. Students shall NOT use other lock and key for locking their rooms. Students are responsible for their possession of all valuables and they should be kept in the cupboard under lock and key. Students shall not leave mobile, ornaments and other valuables unguarded. Students cannot change lock and key without the permission of the **warden** and are advised to get duplicate keys made against loss of keys with the permission of **Principal/Warden**.
8. **The Principal/Warden** has the discretion to inspect any room at any time.
9. Students shall not indulge in any political or communal activity which is detrimental to the law and order and/or against the Government. Students shall not carry on any propaganda or publicity of any nature whatsoever in respect of anything or any matter including political or communal matters.
10. Inmates have to vacate the hostel and handover the key of their rooms to the Warden during long holidays and vacation. In case they wish to keep their luggage in safe custody, they may do so by using the cloakroom facility.
11. Students proceeding on leave are required to inform the same to the Warden in writing. Those found absent without prior sanction shall be expelled from the hostel.
12. A minimum of one month notice is necessary in case a student wishes to vacate the hostel. A student will have to vacate the hostel within five days of completion of her/his examination or any such academic requirement whichever is later. In case a student does not vacate her/his room, the belongings will be removed from the room and room will be locked by the **Warden / Principal** with no responsibility of the Management for the same.
13. The student shall pay hostel fee along with deposit and _____ mess _____ fee for one year in advance at the time of admission. The term for the hostel fee is one academic _____ year of the respective programme for the respective Institute in which the student is _____

studying. Hostel Rent is exclusive of electricity charges and water charges. Electricity charges and water charges will be collected from each student by equally dividing the actual bill amount.

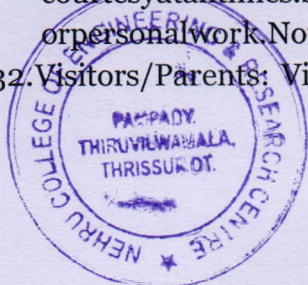
14. Hostel admission is provided for one year. Hence hostel fees and charges are also collected for one year only. When a student desires to continue to use the hostel facilities he/she may do so provided his/her hostel re-admission is recommended and approved by the Hostel Warden, Principal. This system is applicable for every year.
15. It is mandatory for all students staying in the Hostel to undergo medical checkup. Any student, who is not well, shall immediately report to authority and avail the treatment. In case of medical emergency, the student will be shifted/referred to the hospital.
16. Dress Code: The students should be decently dressed when they are out of rooms. The decision, as to what constitutes a decent dress remains vested with the Hostel authority.
17. Silence: Strict silence shall be observed in hostel from 12.00 am to 6.00 am. Care should be taken at all times to ensure that music/loud talking is NOT audible outside the room. Any manner of festivities and noise making/celebrations will not be entertained, which may cause disturbance to other inmates in the hostel premises. Recreational facilities to be turned off at 10.30 pm.
18. No gambling of any kind shall be allowed on the premises of the hostel.
19. No student shall bring or store any firearm, ammunition, explosive and inflammable goods on the premises of the hostel.
20. Alcohol / Drugs / Smoking: Students shall not bring, take and/or drink any alcohol/ intoxicating drink, drug or substance of any kind what so ever and/or smoke in the room and/or any part of premises. The same shall apply to visitors also. An occurrence of such behavior shall invite strict disciplinary action leading to rustication from the Institute.
21. If any common property is damaged or lost, the same shall be charged in equal share to the students who are in common use of that property. Students shall not drive any pegs or nails into walls or stick post on walls, windows and doors.
22. Fixture: Student shall not bring any extra furniture or other fixture in the room. All furniture and fixture in the rooms allotted to students must be cared for properly. Students will be required to pay double the original cost of any item found missing from their room. Students will also be required to pay twice the charges of the repair to items that found to have been willfully damaged or have been damaged on account of misuse or unfair wear and tear.
 - a) Interchange of Furniture/Fixture: Students are prohibited from interchanging any furniture/fixture from one point/location in the hostel to another. Besides a penal recovery, students involved in such activities will be expelled from the hostel.
 - b) Assets in Common Areas/Corridors: Theft/damage to hostel assets in common areas/corridors will be recovered from all students of the flank/wing involved. In

case of theft/damage to items that pertain to usage by the complete hostel, the recoveries will be made from all the occupants of the hostel.

23. As one room is shared by more than one student, it becomes important for each person to take care of his/her property. Hostel inmates are therefore strictly warned not to keep any cash, gold jewellery, or any costly items etc. in their rooms. Hostel authorities will not be responsible for any loss of money, jewelry or personal belongings of any student.
24. **Ragging:** Ragging in any form is BANNED. It is a cognizable offence and violation will invite action as per law of the land in addition to rustication from the Institute. Being a silent spectator and not reporting/stopping others indulging in ragging is also an offence and will invite similar disciplinary action. Accepting/undergoing ragging and not reporting to this is also an offence. Please report any incident immediately to any member of the **Anti-Ragging Committee/Warden/Principal** directly at any time of the day/night.
25. **Electricity Restrictions:** No electric appliances shall be permitted in the room, failing which the **Warden** will have the right to confiscate the gadget. The lights in the bathroom should be used only as and when necessary and shall not be kept on when the bathroom is not used. While leaving the room students should take care to put off the lights and fans without fail. Table lamps can be used for study purpose after 12.30 am.
26. **Attendance Register:** Attendance will be taken by the Warden before 6.30 pm every evening. Hostelites have to sign the attendance register every day before 6.30 pm. After that the student is not allowed to go out of the hostel.
27. All inmates are expected to be in the Hostel before 6.30 pm or Roll call time, whichever is earlier.
28. **Celebration of Festivals and Birthdays:** Student shall take prior permission of the **Warden / Principal** for celebrating any festivals and birthdays. Birthdays should be held in a common place in hostel for one to two hours between 7.00 pm to 9.00 pm. There should not be any kind of physical discomfort. No outside guest or interference of any kind will be allowed.
29. **Cleanliness:** Students shall keep their room, veranda and surroundings neat, clean and tidy at all times and shall not throw anything including rubbish, in such places or any premises in the hostel except in the dustbin or the place specifically provided for the said purpose. No wet clothes should be dried on the furniture or in corridors/balconies. The **Warden** has the right to confiscate any such clothes hung for drying in the balconies. No student shall store any cooked food in the room.
30. **Pets:** Students shall not bring and/or keep any pets in the premises including fish, cats, dogs, and so on. Students should desist from pampering stray dog by offering food, petting them etc.
31. **Hostel Staff:** Students shall treat the staff and housekeeping staff of the Hostel with due courtesy at all times. Service of the housekeeping staff shall NOT be utilized for private or personal work. No tips in cash or kind will be given to the staff of the Hostel.
32. **Visitors/Parents:** Visitors/parents are allowed to visit a student only in the visitor's

lobby. No visitor is allowed in the hostel between 7.00pm and 6.00am. No students shall keep talking with visitors in compound, either in or outside the gate/lane. No students shall take any visitor including her/his parents to the room. Personal servants/Domestic helpers are not allowed inside the rooms. The parents should give an undertaking to cooperate with the authority and should be available on call.

33. Hostel gates / doors shall remain closed between 9.30 pm to 5.30 am.
34. No parents / guardians are allowed to enter the hostel premises or to meet the wards without producing their ID Card issued from the office at the time of admission.
35. Parking of cycles / motor bikes/ other vehicles are permitted only in the area provided for the parking purpose.
36. Suggestion Box/Register: Suggestions and complaints should be either deposited in the "Suggestion Box" or should be entered in the "Suggestion Register" kept in the hostel premises. Suggestion form is also available in the Hostel.
37. Writing, sticking band, bills, posters and disfiguring the rooms & doors are strictly prohibited.
Students are not permitted to convene meeting of any sort anywhere in the Hostel premises.
38. Hostel inmates should not remain in their rooms during class hours. Only sick persons may stay back with valid permission from Warden/Principal.
Warden/Principal is having the full power to enter any rooms in the hostel at any time and when required on situation wants to do so.

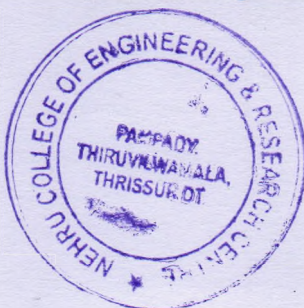


Authorities has the right to discontinue Hostel accommodation given to a student on account of misconduct and/or violation of rules and regulations.

40. Hostel is meant for facilitating studies. Therefore, silence should be maintained especially from 8.30 pm to 6.00 am. Students should not disturb other students by conducting parties, playing music, talking loudly over mobile phones, etc.,
41. HOSTEL REPRESENTATIVES. There will be two Floor Representatives for each floor mutually nominated by the residents of the respective floors to represent students' problems. The floor representatives will represent student problems regarding maintenance, mess and other facilities and work to safeguard the Universities interests. Any untoward incident at the hostel or any non-compliance of rules should be reported by the floor representative to the Administration immediately.
42. Playing instruments/music at a loud volume, singing aloud, shouting and making noise of any kind causing disturbance to others is discouraged. It is expected that hostel residents will respect each other's privacy, rest hours and peace of mind by not making undue noise. Habitual offenders are subject to punishment by the disciplinary committee.



MESS RULES:

1. Once a student joins the hostel, he / she are deemed to have become a member of the allotted mess until he / she vacates the hostel officially.
2. The mess is run by the nominated caterers.
3. Availing Mess facility is mandatory for all Residents admitted into the hostel.
4. A lump-sum amount equal to the chargeable amount for the entire Academic year shall be paid as deposit during start of academic year as Mess advance, which shall be adjusted against the Monthly Mess bills, generated at the end of every month. Students who fail to pay the deposit amount will not be eligible for hostel admission.
5. **Refund / Mess cutare not allowed for the absence from the hostel.**
6. **Refund / Mess cutis not applicable in cases where a Resident skips the mess for part-day.**
7. All inmates are bound to inform the Warden when they are absent or on leave from the hostel in order to avoid the wastage of food. **Reduction of the mess charges for absentees are calculated only for more than 5 declared holidays by the college.** Other absentees are liable to pay the mess charges without reduction.
8. No Resident is permitted to take the Mess utensils/plates outside the hostel dining hall. If anyone is found taking the utensils/plates outside the mess or in their rooms, he/she is liable to be penalized by the **hostel authority**.
9. Mess Menu is as decided by **Hostel Committe** based on the Students proposal and is thus done duly considering the culinary priorities of various regions
10. Students are requested not to waste food. Outsiders are not allowed in the mess. Guests are allowed in mess with prior permission of the **Warden** and charges applicable. Outside food/dabbas are strictly not permitted in the hostel

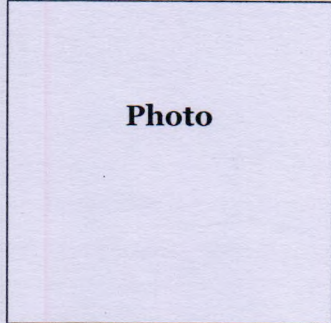



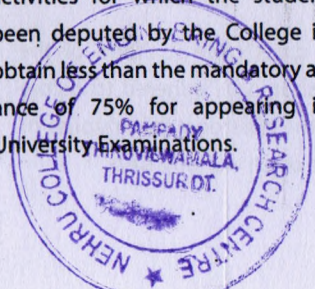

1. Any student admitted to Nehru College of Engineering & Research Centre, Pampady, Thiruvilwamala, Thrissur 680 588 shall undergo the prescribed course of study as per the stipulations of University of Calicut, Government of Kerala, APJ Abdul Kalam Technological University and directions of AICTE, New Delhi.
2. College working hours will be between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. on all working days.
3. As far as possible the students must attend all classes through out the course achieving 100% attendance.
4. Every student should have 75% attendance as eligibility for writing university examinations. The Vice Chancellor/Syndicate of the University is the authority to condone the shortage of attendance up to 10% on the recommendation of the Principal based on his or her participation in sports, literary and extra curricular activities for which the student has been deputed by the College if they obtain less than the mandatory attendance of 75% for appearing in the University Examinations.





5. In order to make our students more fluent in conversational English it is mandatory that all students should speak in English within the campus.
6. Students are required to follow the proper procedure while availing leave. A leave requisition form has to be submitted in the Office either before or immediately after availing leave with the permission of parent/ guardian.
7. Students are required to attend classes wearing decent attire.
8. Students are expected to take care of their personal property and the Management accepts no responsibility in respect of the loss of property of students in the College premises or for accidental injury caused during the course.
9. All entries made in the application for admission ought to be correct and authentic and no material shall be concealed.
10. a) All fees pertaining to the college are to be paid on or before the prescribed date intimated in the prospectus or calendar and as per the undertaking provided.

- b) For the late payment of fees, late fees may be levied.
- c) Fees once paid will under no circumstances be refunded whether in full or part even if he/she does not join the Institution or joins and discontinues the course immediately after joining in the middle. The parent/guardian must note that students are admitted under the specific condition, mentioned above. This applies equally to a student who has been expelled from the College on disciplinary grounds. In case a student discontinues for any reason, what so ever he has to pay the balance of fees for the whole course for which he has been admitted.
11. All original certificates are to be deposited with the College and the same will be forwarded to the university and it will be returned only after the verification and after the full payment of the course fees.
12. For every payment which should be made to the College Office, a receipt in the proper form duly signed by the Accountant should be obtained.
13. Every student will be issued an

14. Any other lawful dues to the College should be paid promptly when the College makes a request.

15. Students are required to undertake case study visits and architectural study tours as an integral part of the course and the expenses for the same should be borne by them.

16. Every student should get readmitted to the course at the beginning of every academic year irrespective of the duration of the course. This is to ensure by the Principal that the deficiencies noted in the performance of the students in the preceding academic year are made good by proper counseling and other remedial measures by the College. Application will be supplied for the said readmission free of cost. If deficiencies are not removed totally, the student may be given conditional admission with proper undertaking by the student

jointly with the parent. When readmitted to the higher class a readmission card will be issued to the student by the Principal/Director. In case of readmission for a student who loses one year should apply for readmission to the University of Calicut through Principal and an application fee prescribed by the University to be remitted in University account. Further on confirmation of readmission the student shall pay the requisite tuition fees to the college and an readmission slip to be obtained from the Administrative Office.

17. First year students are advised to stay in college hostel or must come from their respective home.

18. a List of working days and holidays given in this academic calendar are applicable to the students.

b. Holidays for faculties and administrative staffs will be declared as and when required.

19. Students can download all forms related to academic and non academic from the respective college websites for their usage (Eg:- TC Request Form,

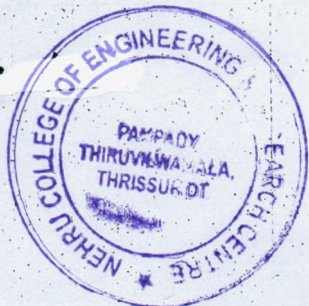

4. Any pending disciplinary action

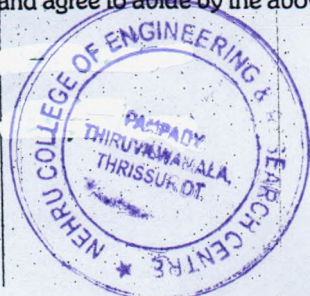

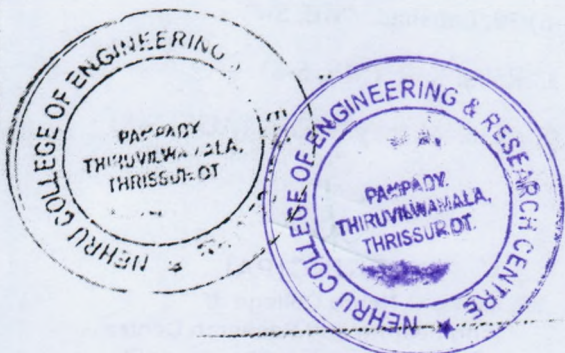
The faculty members and the students discussed the following issues concerning the welfare of the students.


1. The students raised the point that bus.nos.10, 27, and 37 are in a bad condition and traveling in it has become hazardous. Air Conditioner in bus no 42 is not working properly. Necessary steps are to be initiated to ensure the comfortable travel of the students.
2. The students have raised their concern about the closure of the 'Nescafe' and the 'Burger' shops in the campus and are of the opinion that they have to be reopened. The quality of all the food items provided in the canteen should be improved. More staff should be appointed at the counters in the canteen during the morning and evening breaks.

7. Some of the equipment's in the EEE Machine lab are not working properly. Quality of the ID cards provided to the first year students should be improved. Students want all the Saturdays as holiday so that they get more time for studies.

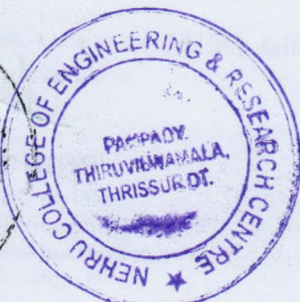
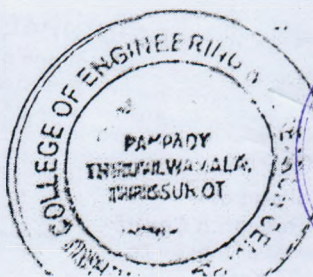
In honour of our beloved Founder Chairman, Late Sri.P.K.Das, a minute silence was observed.

The faculty members and the students discussed the following issues concerning the welfare of the students.

1. The final year ME students said that the placement training imparted to the students was not very effective last time. More competent teams should be chosen for the placement training this time. They also suggested that there should be continuity in the training in order to ensure the development of the students' soft skills.
2. The S-3 Mechatronics students complained that the noise from the server room of the Electronics Lab on the ground floor of the Bhaskara block is really annoying and disturbing that they find it difficult to concentrate in the class.

3. Faculties should make sure that strict action to be taken against the students and inform the parents accordingly.

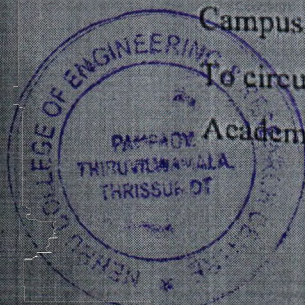
